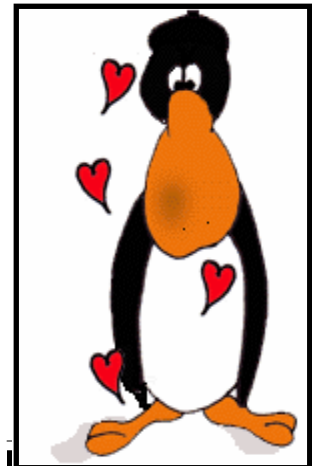
Your membership is important to us, please renew ASAP. We will miss you if you do not renew. Also, if you want to continue to receive our newsletters you must be a member.
