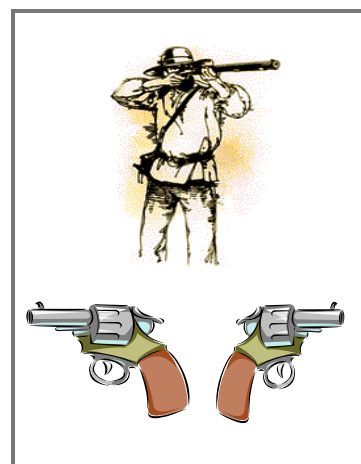
HANK HUNSINGER 9TH ANNUAL SHOOTING LEAGUE
